RACE PACKAGE

This Inlet Spring Regatta is a 200 m race event hosted by the Dogwood Nothin' Dragon Masters and managed by G2G.

Getting There

- [Rocky Point Park](#), also known as Rocky Point, is situated along Burrard Inlet in Port Moody, BC.
- The closest SkyTrain Station is [Moody Centre Station](#) on the Millennium Line.

Parking and Drop Off Area

- A drop off area for team equipment will be located in the [Rocky Point parking lot](#).
- There are free parking lots at and around Rocky Point Park but please note that they have a 4-hour limit, as do the streets around the park. Please read the signs.
- Parking is available at [West Coast Express/Moody Centre SkyTrain](#) for \$3.00/day and tickets may be purchased at the Compass machines by the turnstiles. Once you activate the touch screen look for the Parking button on the lower right. Tickets may also be purchased through the [TransLink Park&Go app](#). The zone number for the lot is 6049.
- Google maps estimates the walking time to the venue to be 9-minutes. Use the stairs at the west end of the parking lot. At the top of the stairs turn right and cross the overpass over the railway tracks toward the water.

Health Protocols

Inlet Spring Regatta is following current BC Health Guidelines for events. While mask-wearing is at your discretion, we encourage teams to wear masks to marshaling and to the dock and boats.

Registration / Information table

- The race grid will be emailed when it is available and will be posted on the website.
- The registration table will be located in the Gazebo at the Rocky Point Pier.
- Signed waivers must be handed in before the first race. [Click here to download.](#)
- Teams must provide a cell # and email address to be used during the regatta - this can be done at the registration table.
- Teams must provide information on any current medical concerns in case of an emergency.
- **Manager's meeting** will be held by race organizers adjacent to the gazebo in the marshaling area at 7:30 AM.

- Tent sites are **10 x 20 ft** - no tent pegs allowed as the site is a paved area.
- Since tents are on concrete, teams must **bring anchor weights** for their tents.
- Zip ties are suggested to secure tents in case of windy conditions.
- Any materials brought to secure tents **MUST** be removed at the end of the day.

- Spares can sign up ahead of time through the [event spares paddlers form.](#)

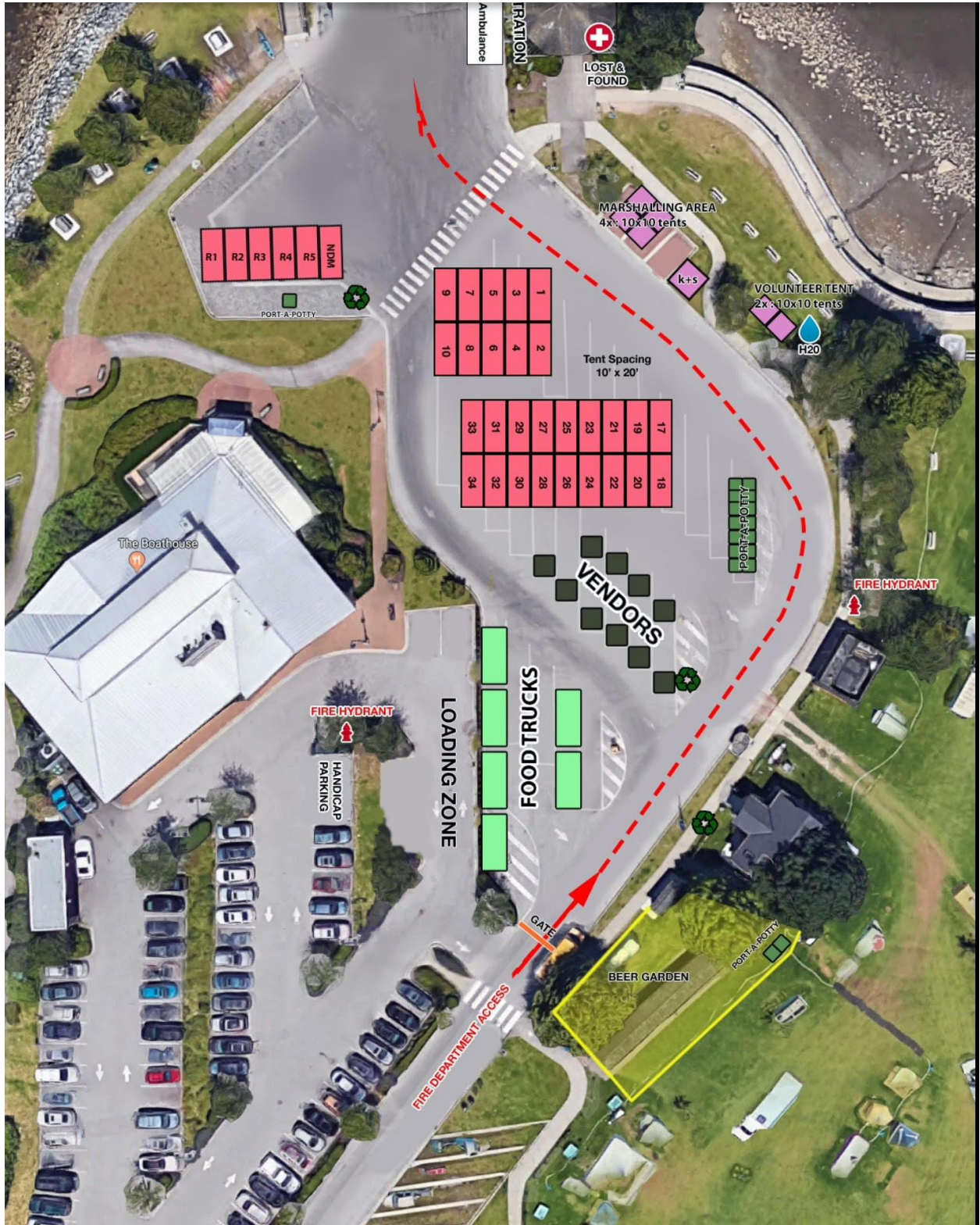
Drinking Water
